We will do our best to keep everyone informed of the most recent paving schedule. During this paving phase we plan to keep one lane open of the road being paved almost all of the time. There may be short periods when the road will be closed and traffic redirected but this will be kept to an absolute minimum and for only a very short time. Please drive carefully in the work areas, observe all the traffic signs and pay attention to the traffic flagmen.
